

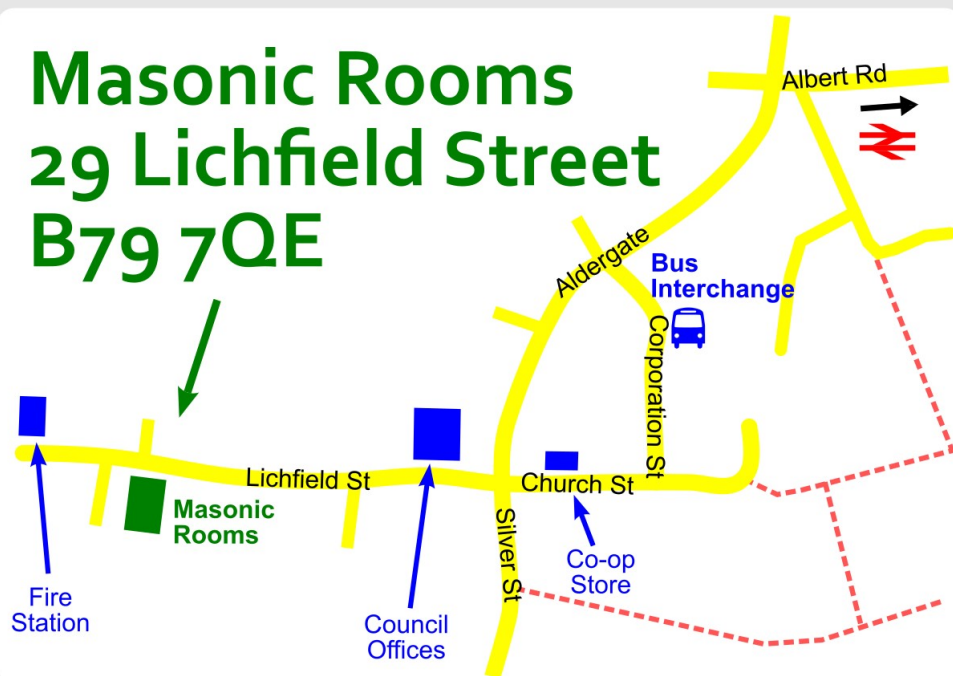

The Beer List Tamworth 2018

Square tick boxes are 9 gallon firkins; round tick boxes are 4½ gallon pins. The pins – unconventional beers flavoured with exotic ingredients – usually sell out first!

The beers are racked up in programme order, with the exception of the pins, which are in the corner formed by the two bays of stillage

ANSTEY ALE, Anstey, Leicestershire

- Elbow Grease 4.5%** Normally only seen in Hinckley's Elbow Room, this is a specially commissioned ale. It's chestnut coloured, in the style of a fruity, smooth traditional English bitter.

ARBOR, Bristol, Gloucestershire

- Mosaic 4.0%** Gluten free beer showcasing the Mosaic hop. Refreshing and easy drinking with floral and tropical fruit flavours.
- MEGS Bomb 4.7%** Heavily hopped with a whole load of tasty hops: Mosaic, Equinox, Galaxy and Simcoe.

BAD SEED, Malton, North Yorkshire

- Short Stop 3.0%** Table beer with plenty of hop character. Oats are included to give a bigger mouthfeel.

BEATNIKZ REPUBLIC, Manchester, Greater Manchester

- Summer Pale 3.6%** Easy-drinking pale session ale hopped with a variety of American hops.
- Idaho 7 Extra Pale 4.4%** Made using the new Idaho 7 hop - tropical fruits, citrus, resinous pine and even hints of black tea!

BEOWULF, Brownhills, Staffordshire

- Vanilla Gold 4.3%** Easy-drinking golden ale with a rounded edge of vanilla.
- Black & Blueberry 4.5%** Lovely dark ale finished off with a judicious dose of blueberries.
- Clout 6.0%** A rare outing for one of Phil's strong specialities. Rich and fruity with a good bitter hop finish.

BLACK IRIS, New Basford, Nottinghamshire

- Stab In The Dark 5.0%** Pitch black roasty stout. Look out for notes of coffee, chocolate, vanilla and dark fruit.

BLACK LODGE, Liverpool, Merseyside

- Taking Liberties 4.9%** They certainly are. A raspberry ice cream beer, though we can't guarantee a ripple effect.

BLYTHER, Hamstall Ridware, Staffordshire

- One Hundred And Eighty! 3.4%**
One-off pale festival special made with an experimental hop known at present just as CR180. Your feedback welcome!
- Knobbled Horse 4.7%**
Another novel festival special, a salted caramel stout.

BREW MONSTER, Cwmbra, Gwent

- Leviathan IPA 4.0%**
Light and mellow session IPA with aromas of citrus, pine and grapefruit.
- White Label 4.2%**
Rye ale with malty, biscuity flavours, hints of stone fruit and a spicy rye finish

BREW YORK, York, North Yorkshire

- Tonkoko 4.3%**
Bounty in a glass. A milk stout with huge coconut and chocolate flavours. Creamy and easy drinking.

BROTHERHOOD, Westbury, Wiltshire

- Mango Pale Ale 4.0%**
100 pureed mangoes in each batch so it'll be a bloody miracle if it even pours from the cask! Perle and Mosaic hops enhance the fruity flavours.
- American Red 4.5%**
Citrus to the fore with notes of orange and tangerine, and a kick of zesty grapefruit. Summit hops.

CHURCH END, Ridge Lane, Warwickshire

- Bee-Limey 4.4%**
This golden honey and lime beer should give you a buzz.
- Peppa The Porter 4.5%**
A black pepper porter - hot stuff?
- Loco Coco Stout 4.6%**
A smooth stout with plenty of coconut and a subtle addition of cloves.
- I'll Tell Mum 5.0%**
Fruity strong ale dry-hopped with Citra; should have nice lemony aromatics.
- Orange Order 5.0%**
An orange IPA - fresh oranges and an assertively hoppy brew should make an intriguing combination.
- Irish Toffee 5.1%**
The lovely Irish Coffee (Pew's Porter with Irish Whiskey) with a healthy dosing of toffee for extra smoothness!
- Don't Panic! 7.0%**
You won't be able to panic after this one. This is a special cask of Rest In Peace which has been aged for 18 months. Warming, smooth and mellow.

CLAVELL & HIND, Birdlip, Gloucestershire

- Coachman 3.8%**
Light golden ale both moreish and refreshing. Citrusy hops with a gentle addition of fresh ginger.
- Rookwood 4.4%**
Ruby ale with darker malts, and Magnum and Bramling Cross hops for a fruity character.

CROFT, Bristol, Gloucestershire

- Westide 4.5%**
Light copper-coloured American Pale Ale; US hops for citrus and pine notes plus Australian Enigma hops for woody and spicy edges.
- Deep Red 5.5%**
A red IPA featuring eight different malts and four hop varieties. Biscuit, burnt raisins, caramel, berry and lychee flavours.

CROWN BREWHOUSE, Elford, Staffordshire

- Trapeze 4.3%**
New session ale from one of the tiniest brew houses in the branch. Golden amber, using Bravo, Golding and Cascade hops.

DIG BREW, Digbeth, Birmingham

- Marianne 4.0%**
A single-hop pale ale using Taiheke hops, a new one for us. Vegan finings.

DOGBREATH, Kinver, Staffordshire

- Jailbait 4.4%**
The first of a pair of smoked ales, and this is the weirder of the two - blonde, creamy and smoked. Enjoy!
- Smoke On The Water 5.9%**
Safer territory? A smoked porter, promising smoky, malty, peaty flavours.

DOWR KAMMEL, Lower Lank, Cornwall

- Delank Dynamite 5.1%**
Dark brown porter with smooth roast, bitter coffee and malt flavours. Hints of stone fruit, finishing dry.
- Goldsworthy IPA 6.5%**
New IPA.

FIXED WHEEL, Blackheath, West Midlands

- Quick Release 3.0%**
Crisp light ale with Chinook & Equinox hops giving grapefruit, lemon and green pepper flavours.
- Café Culture 4.5%**
A nice roasty coffee milk stout. Features Indian Monsoon Malabar beans, nearly as good as Nescafé.

FREESTYLE, Shustoke, Warwickshire

- Griffin Dark 3.8%** A classic mild, near-black and roasty, with a long dry finish.
- Ale House Rock 5.0%** New brew in the style of a premium fruity bitter, full-bodied and smooth.

FURNACE, Derby, Derbyshire

- Trudy Knight 5.2%** Hazy straw-coloured beer in a German wheat beer style. Graininess with light banana and clove notes. Gluten free.

GREAT HECK, Great Heck, North Yorkshire

- Epiphany 4.5%** Pale golden seriously hopped APA, floral with fruity, spicy and citrus flavours.

GREEN DUCK, Stourbridge, West Midlands

- Megalomania 4.5%** A new golden ale for September, where Kazbek and Brewers Gold hops should give fresh flavours of lemon and blackcurrant.
- Heaven Sent 5.0%** Another new one, a chocolate milk stout promising biscuity notes, a gentle roastiness and flavours of rich chocolate.

GRITCHIE, Ashmore, Wiltshire

- English Lore 4.0%** Traditional bitter with touches of caramel and a good balance of English hops.

HAL'S, Dursley, Gloucestershire

- Hal's Gold 4.4%** Easy-drinking Goldings-hopped ale from a new nanobrewery. Honeyed sweetness on the palate and a floral finish.

KINVER, Kinver, Staffordshire

- Pek's Pivo 4.0%** Festival special dedicated to the late Pek, a regular attendee at beer festivals across the land. Pale and hoppy.
- Half Centurion 5.0%** Award winner in this year's Strong Bitter category of CAMRA's Champion Beer of Britain competition! Golden and malty with a commanding hop finish.

POMONA ISLAND, Salford, Greater Manchester

- Pale 3.8%** A beer from a new brewery where the hops are forever changing. This version of Pale features Centennial and Mosaic ...
- APA 5.3%** ... and this version of the American Pale Ale showcases Amarillo, Citra and Cascade .

REDEMPTION, Tottenham, Greater London

- Steam Effort 4.5%** Brewed in the style of a California Common ale or steam beer, a hybrid where lager yeast is used at ale fermenting temperatures.

RED MOON, Yardley, West Midlands

- Screaming Dwarf 4.5%** From a new brewery started by two friends, whose "beer names are inspired by their own life events." Oh dear. A gold-coloured ale with caramel notes combined with rich hop flavours and a citrus finish.

REVOLUTIONS, Whitwood, West Yorkshire

- Switch #10 4.5%** The tenth outing for this changing-hop pale ale. This one features Ahtanum and Summit.

SHINY, Little Eaton, Derbyshire

- Happy People 4.2%** Named after either our door staff, or the R.E.M. hit from the 1990s. Pale with five different hops and plenty of hop aromatics.

SPERRIN, Ansley, Warwickshire

- Full Ration 3.5%** Roasty dry mild tempered with chocolate and coconut.
- '66 3.8%** World Cup beer with a nice smoky honey addition. Will not need renaming for the next tournament ...
- Give Up The Ghost 4.0%** Crisp pale ale with Mosaic hops.
- Hoodoo 4.8%** ... you think you are kidding Mr Hitler? Full-bodied ruby beer pepped up with raspberries and lime.
- Pike's Plum Porter 5.0%** Sophisticated plum porter with solid fruitiness but a plum stone dryness.
- Lights Out! 6.8%** The stunning Thick as Thieves stout with the addition of caramel and vanilla for extra smoothness.

TAMWORTH, Tamworth, Staffordshire



- Hopmaster 3.9%** Single-hopped golden ale from Tamworth's very own brewery, 500 yards away.
- Cha Cha Cha 4.5%** Dark with chocolate, cherry and chilli!
- Tongue Thaid 5.0%** A Thai-style pale - lemongrass, chilli and coriander.
- Whopper 6.0%** An IPA-style golden ale with an assertive resinous hoppiness and a dry bitter finish.
- Don't Tell 'em Pike 6.5%** Well we'll tell you - ginger and chilli plus New Zealand hops.
- Stupid Boy! 7.2%** See page 9 for the full story of this stronger-than-expected fest special!

TAW VALLEY, North Tawton, Devon

- Black Ops 3.9%** From Britain's only thatched microbrewery! A dark hoppy ale with four different types of hops and roasted black malt flavours
- Taw Golden Brown 4.5%** A traditional Devonshire bitter style but with a more modern hop profile and a "texture like sun." Yeah, we don't know what that means either.

THORNBRIDGE, Bakewell, Derbyshire

- Strawberry Lucaria 4.5%** Round off summer with this strawberry ice cream porter. Gently sweet and fruitily delicious.

TURNING POINT, Kirkbymoorside, North Yorkshire

- Chaos Theory 5.0%** Full-bodied oatmeal pale with added honey and marigold flowers.

VELVET OWL, Caerphilly, Glamorgan

- Old Sport 4.5%** An orange Vermont ale, meaning orange peel and Vermont yeast. Promises tropical fruit & citrus notes and a soft & juicy mouthfeel. Unfiltered and unfinned, hence naturally hazy and vegan friendly.
- Catherine II 7.4%** Russian Imperial stout, named after the empress who popularised the style. A richly full-flavoured beer which has lots going on.

WANDER BEYOND, Manchester, Greater Manchester

- Peak 3.8%** Bitter with a simple malt structure, and Citra and Mosaic hops for nice fruity, aromatic edges.

WHITACRE BREWING, Nether Whitacre, Warwickshire



- Ted's Tipple 3.8%** A rare outing for this beer which, generally, is only occasionally available at the Dog Inn in Nether Whitacre. An amber, full-bodied bitter.
- Mad Dog 4.8%** Only the second cask of this beer to be produced! Said to be a traditional bitter with a bit of a bite.

WILD WEATHER, Aldermaston, Berkshire

- Cry Of The Upstarts 4.2%** Old-school amber bitter with modern hops. Soft fruits on the nose, subtle dry finish.
